The name Ørsted Energy comes from Hans Christian Ørsted. He was a famous scientist and innovator from Denmark that discovered electromagnetism in 1820



Key Statistics

- 5,800 employees, over 900 staff based in the UK.
- Aim to supply power to 30 million people by 2025 with offshore wind.
- 12 offshore wind farms in operation across the UK.
- Built the worlds first bio plant, turning waste into energy
- They will stop using coal by 2023, they will use sustainably sourced wood chips and wood pellets.

What Countries Do Ørsted Energy Operate In?

- United Kingdom - Offshore wind, waste-recycling plant, storage, sales of energy.
- United States - Offshore wind, onshore wind, solar (under construction), storage (under construction).
- Denmark - Sales of energy, biomass-fired power plant, fossil-fuelled power plant.
- Sweden - Sales of energy
- The Netherlands - Offshore wind
- Germany - Offshore wind, sales of energy
- Taiwan - Offshore Wind
- South Korea - Offshore Wind

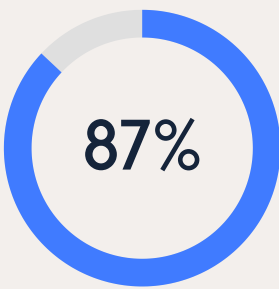


Fuel Mix



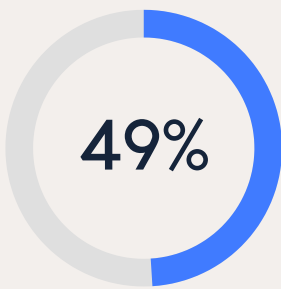
Percentage of renewable energy from Ørsted's fuel mix
